# Job requirements in tech. sector

#### <u>Technical manager</u>:

MSc Architecture or graduated theatrologist / 3yr. work experience

#### Stage manager:

Technical secondary school degree / 5yr. exp.

#### Scenographer:

 University degree (Academy of Fine Arts or Civil Engineering – department of architecture) / 3yr. exp.

#### Set decorator:

Secondary school degree – technical course / 2yr. exp.

## Job requirements in tech. sector

- Tailor Wig designer/maker Wardrobe supervisor/Dresser - Carpenter/M.Carpenter -Property master:
  - Secondary school degree / 3yr. exp.
- Sound technician:
  - Electrotechnical secondary school degree / 3yr. exp.
- Lighting technician:
  - Electrotechnical secondary school degree / 3yr. exp.

## Main problems in tech. sector

- Outdated equipment
- Scarce investments in technical hardware and software
- Only a few theatres have skilled and professional sound and lighting technicians
- Most sound and lighting technicians are self educeted with no proper professional education in the field

### Main problems in tech. sector

- There is a lack of professional and educated sound and lighting designers, almost nonexistent
- The majority of stage managers earn their jobs almost exclusively through work experience, with no prior education in the fild of theatre production
- Sound, lighting, wardrobe, make-up and other professions had a change ni generations and have been reduced to scrapbooking and basic managing
